

# Stand with Kennedy Youth Services workers

42 workers at **Kennedy Youth Services** are in negotiations with their employer for a first contract.

## **What Kennedy Youth Services wants to do:**

**Force deep concessions on the backs of the front-line workers.** The employer has introduced a 10 year wage scale, starting at \$17/ per hour and reaching \$18.75 a whole decade later.

**Sadly, even basic proposals around improving working conditions have been declined.** And these would be no extra cost.

## **What Kennedy Youth Services refuses to do:**

**Provide a safe work environment job security.** The employer has refused to make changes that would improve health and safety and approaches to violence.

**Follow basic Employment Standards.** The employer has failed to recognize workers' rights to statutory holidays, overtime, meal breaks and vacation pay, as outlined by the law.
